Dear Neighbor,

I wanted you to know that National Grid is developing several Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) sites on Long Island, including one at our Glenwood facility in Glenwood Landing. The site is located at National Grid's Glenwood facility on Shore Road. We're sending you notice to expect construction vehicles near your neighborhood beginning September 21, 2020. There will be no impact to traffic, or parking in your neighborhood.

After our settlement this past November with New York State, CNG was identified as one of the short-term solutions that could help ease the gas supply constraints in our region.

Having CNG as part of our overall gas supply portfolio will help us serve customers in gas constrained areas and help reduce the risks that come from meeting customer demand during extreme cold weather or in the event of a pipeline supply disruption.

The Glenwood CNG facility will operate on a seasonal basis. Its use is dependent upon the occurrence of extreme winter temperatures or in the event of a supply disruption. During a typical winter, it would likely be operational for a few days, at most; during milder winters, it might not be operated at all.

Safety is our top priority. We've been in contact with local municipalities and Fire Departments about the need and use of this site. The site will only be in operation during extreme cold winter weather events or major supply disruptions and otherwise have limited or no operations.


